Pregnant and Parenting Teens in State Care: Addressing the Silent Crisis

Although DCF cannot quantify the number of pregnant or parenting teens, Independent Living surveys show high percentages of teens in care who have had a child. Early statistics show much higher averages of 18 year old females in IL programs who have reported having a child compared to the national average. Practices around the state are inconsistent, and there is no clear understanding of the rights for pregnant or parenting teens in care. This training session will help clarify the best practices and valuable resources available in the Broward community.
